Close your eyes and imagine a peaceful place.	PE Create a fitness circuit in your backyard. Include bear crawling, hops, star jumps and skipping. Complete the circuit 5 times. Ask your family member to join you.	Paper Aeroplanes Fold paper to make paper aeroplanes. Ask members of your family to join you for a paper aeroplane race.

You might like to start thinking about your costume now.

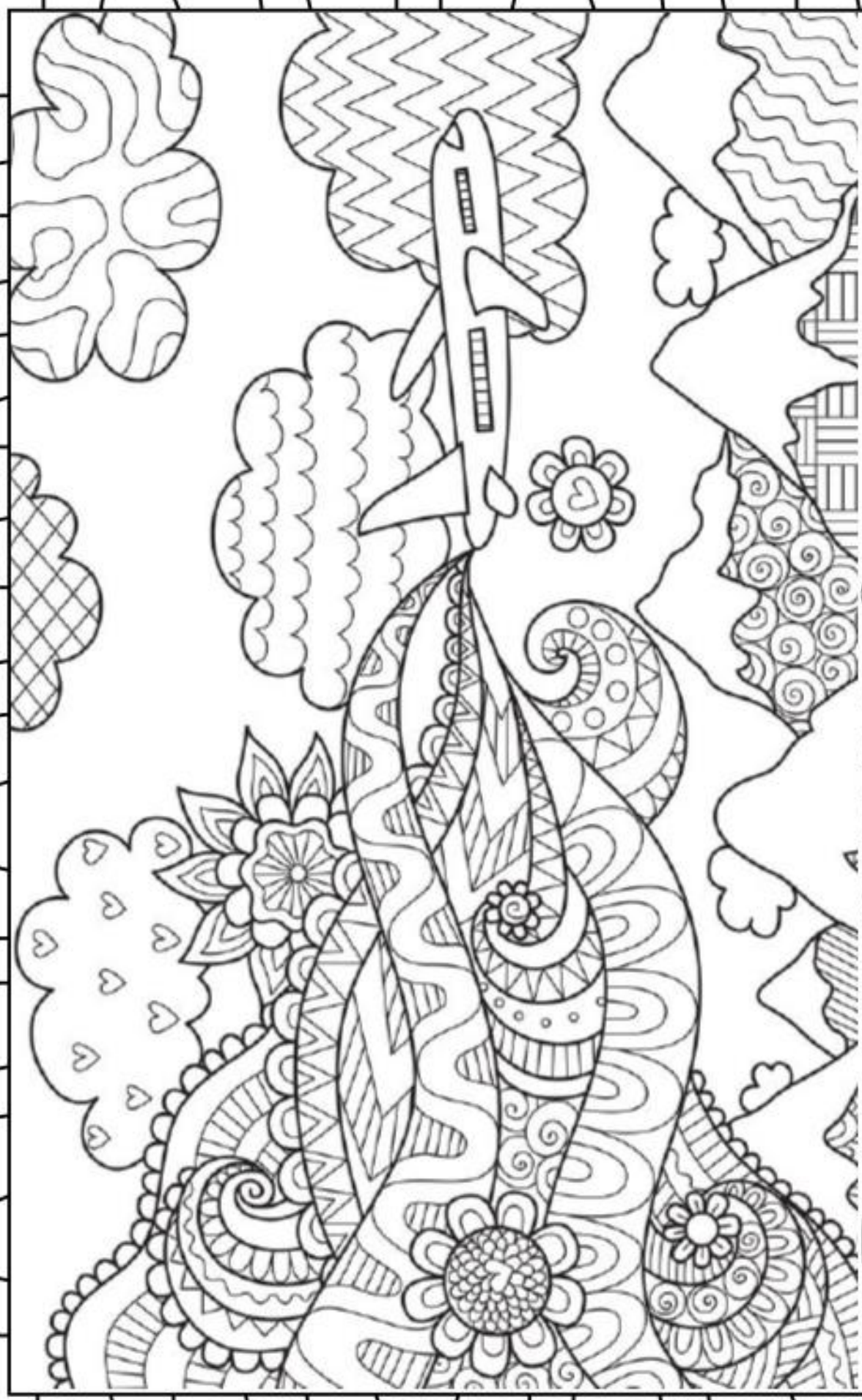
